Each QPEN Division will be open to 75 dogs from any organization, be it NUCS,

It will be 2 runs with call back of top ten entry fee \$285

UFTA, NBDCA, NASTRA, AKC, AMERICAN FIELD, WHAT EVER.

As long as the dog has a champion by his name by that organization it is eligible to enter. It can be Amateur or Open Championship.

The Amateur Division will be open to all Amateur dogs (THE DOG DOES NOT HAVE TO BE A CHAMPION TO ENTER) But will have to go along with NUCS rules for Amateur, cannot have been 2 years old on or before Jan 1st of 2024, for those of you from different organization cannot have placed in the top five of an open division event in any organization and cannot run in both Open and Amateur in this event. Prizes only on Amateur Division, Browning Shot Guns for first. The entry fee will be \$185.00 for Amateur that will be for 2 runs with call back

for the top ten this is made possible by Trophy Time Gun Dogs sponsorship this year. On Chukars first 40 dogs

We run under the National Upland Classic rules, and sanctioned by NUCS you can see the rules on our web site at www.uplandclassic.com

OPEN DIVISION It will be a 2-run event on chukar, we will add both runs together and bring back the top 10 in each division for a finals run and add all 3 scores together for the winner. Entry fees will be \$285.00 with 40% of fees going to the pay back, plus added money and prizes. Entry Deadline will be Sept. 15th` 2024. Browning SHOT GUNS to the open division winners.

The event will be held at Talbot Wildlife Area, We will have motel information up as we get closer to the event. If you would like your runs to go back to your organization other than NUCS you will need to Pay their Sanction fees on top of the entry and make sure they will except the results run under NUCS rules. **There will be no run order posted, the judge and the bird planter will not know who is running in the field till after the field has been planted. So everyone will need to be at the grounds at 7:30 each day.**

NUCS members:

High point points will be awarded for this year's event but will go off of the Number of NUCS members that attend. Example if there is 60 in the pointing and 30 of them are NUCS members the and a NUCS member wins, 60 points would be what you would get for high point the nonmembers will not be counted for high point. We will try this and see how we get along for this year's event Hope to see you all at the event.
